Saturday activity guidelines

Organising a day of activities for over 340 Explorer Scouts requires a lot of organisation, planning and people. With just a little bit of understanding and co-operation from the Explorer Scouts themselves and their leaders everything should run smoothly. So please help us to help you.

To help you prepare for the camp you should have received a kit list for the activities and a list of the activities the Explorer Scouts from your unit have been allocated. **Please make sure that all participants understand what activities they will be doing and what gear to bring before they set off for camp.** This helps us avoid awkward situations when we cannot allow someone to go on an activity because they do not have the minimum required gear from a safety point of view.

If someone cannot do an activity for a real reason, for example they have just broken their arm and so cannot go climbing then, please let us know as soon as possible on the Friday night, we will at VFB near booking in. Everybody should have been allocated activities from a list of their preferred activities so there should be no reason to change. *A small number of units, whose information was received late, have been allocated activities by unit rather than by individual name. On arrival on Friday these units should identify who was going to do which activity on Saturday and provide this information to the activities team.*

The Saturday morning on camp is a hectic time for us all but for the activities to work we need everybody to abide by a few key times and places:

8:30 Flag Break Camp Centre (bring everything you need for your activity)

8:45 Depart for activities

09:00-09:30 on site activities start

12:00 - 13:45 Lunch

13:45 meet at Camp Centre for afternoon activities

14:00 Afternoon activities depart from Camp Centre

16:30 Return from afternoon activities
